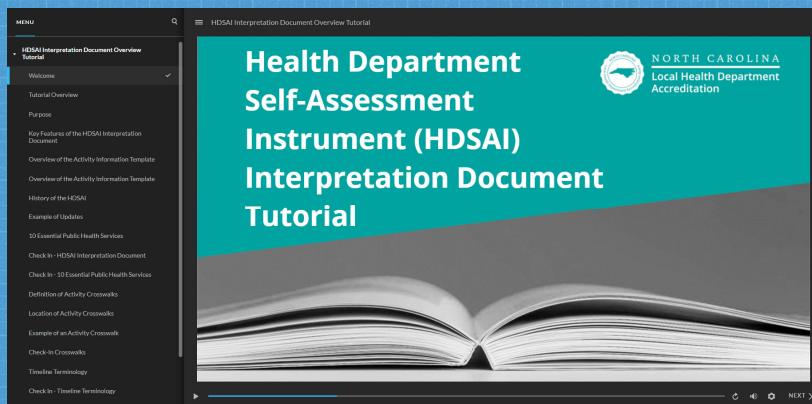

Strategic Direction

The NCLHD Accreditation Board began a strategic planning process in Fall 2020. In April 2021, the NCLHD Accreditation Board approved NCLHDA's [Strategic Roadmap](#), outlining the programs mission, vision, values, and priorities for the next four years (July 2021-June 2025).

In August 2021, in alignment with the Strategic Roadmap, the NCLHDA Program released the [Strategic Work Plan](#). The Work Plan outlines four-year measures to track progress on priorities and goals, as well as a detailed one-year plan to transparently communicate how the program is working towards each priority and goal. This is a living document, and updates will be posted quarterly.



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
